##### & Must Visit:

- **Belmond Hotel das Cataratas (\$\$\$\$)**  
Hotel: Only hotel inside Iguaçu National Park, exclusive early access to falls
- **Rafain Churrascaria Show (\$\$\$)**  
Restaurant: Dinner buffet with cultural show from Latin American countries
- **Brazilian Side of Falls (\$\$)**  
Attraction: Panoramic walkway with breathtaking views, best for photos
- **Argentine Side of Falls (\$\$)**  
Attraction: Upper and lower trails, closer to falls, Devil's Throat viewpoint
- **Macuco Safari Boat Tour (\$\$\$)**  
Activity: Thrilling boat ride to base of falls, expect to get soaked!

### Hotels

- **Recanto Cataratas (\$\$\$)**  
Eco-resort in rainforest with pools and spa

### Attractions

- **Itaipu Dam Tour (\$)**  
World's second-largest hydroelectric power plant
- **Bird Park (\$\$)**  
Walk-through aviaries with toucans, macaws, and tropical birds

### Activities

- **Helicopter Flight (\$\$\$\$)**  
Aerial view of falls and triple border (Brazil/Argentina/Paraguay)

Hotel: Boutique hotel in restored 18th-century mansion
- **Casa do Ouvidor (\$\$)**  
Restaurant: Traditional Minas Gerais cuisine in historic house
- **São Francisco de Assis Church (\$)**  
Attraction: Masterpiece by Aleijadinho with soapstone sculptures
- **Tiradentes Square (\$)**  
Attraction: Central square surrounded by museums and churches, free
- **Mina da Passagem (\$)**  
Attraction: Tour 19th-century gold mine by underground train

### Hotels

- **Pousada do Mondego (\$\$)**  
Historic pousada in colonial building with mountain views

### Restaurants

- **Café Geraes (\$)**  
Coffee house with homemade cakes and local specialties

### Activities

- **Walking Tour (\$\$)**  
Guided walk through cobblestone streets and churches

### Shopping

- **Feira de Pedra-Sabão (\$\$)**  
Market with soapstone handicrafts and local products
